**Neighborhood approval is necessary – signatures will be required for neighboring properties within 200 feet of the property. The signature list can be submitted with the initial application.**

If consent is granted, he/she is responsible for the following rules and regulations for maintaining the permitted fowl. No more than six (6) chickens shall be kept or maintained per property at any time. Roosters are not allowed. An initial application and permit fee of \$40 is required. The annual renewal application fee is \$25. A fine will be imposed \$250 for keeping chickens without a valid permit. Only single-family dwellings in districts that are zoned R-1 or R-2 are allowed to have permitted fowl. Random inspections may be conducted to ensure applicable conditions have been met.

Chickens must be confined in a coop, fowl house, or mobile coop not less than 18 inches in height. An area of 4 to 12 square feet per chicken is required. It must be completely enclosed and designed to prevent the entry of predators. It must be well ventilated and drained, and kept clean and sanitary. Feed for permitted fowl must be stored in rat-proof containers. Slaughtering of chickens or selling of eggs is forbidden
